- For the position of Automotive Heavy Duty Mechanic, applicants must have a certificate or diploma in heavy-duty mechanics and a minimum of three (3) years of relevant professional experience. Similarly.
- Candidates applying for the Computer Science Instructor role must possess a certificate or diploma in computer science, along with at least three (3) years of teaching or practical experience.
- The role of Refrigeration and Air Conditioning Instructor requires a certificate or diploma in refrigeration and air conditioning, with no less than three (3) years of experience in installation, maintenance, and instruction.

- Applicants for the Graphic Arts Instructor position must hold a certificate or diploma in graphic arts and demonstrate a minimum of three (3) years of relevant experience.

Across all positions, MVTC is seeking individuals with strong communication and organizational skills, the ability to work both independently and collaboratively, and a high level of integrity and professionalism.
